TO MEMBERS OF THE LORD ELGIN COMMUNITY



MESSAGES


This yearbook is a collection of pictures that recall the activities and events of 1975-76. As with any collection, however, only certain elements of the total school happenings can be included.

When you graduate from Lord Elgin, please realize that you are leaving a very special school.


