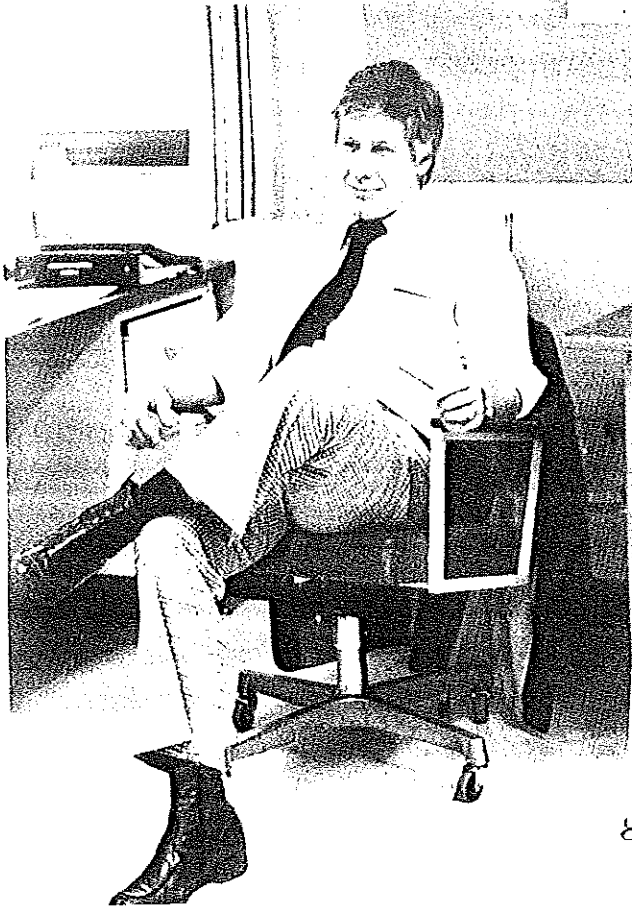
This very fine Yearbook is a tribute to the quality of those who are contributing so much to the success of the school.
